The **Student Innovation Tour** is co-located with the [SOUTH-TEC event taking place at the TD Convention Center](#), 1 Exposition Drive, Greenville, SC 29607. It is a **first come, first served registration** process with only **200-high school students attending each day** from **October 24-26, 2017 from 8:30 AM – 1:00 PM**.

Your school can invite pre-engineering or career and technical education students and faculty staff to accompany your group. Please maintain a ratio of at least one chaperone per ten students.

Students will explore exhibits of advanced technologies, talk with industry experts, see the latest manufacturing innovations, and meet university students studying advanced manufacturing careers. An exciting tour stop for students is to compete in the [Rippl3D additive manufacturing challenge](#) hands-on student activity.
